A Senior First Aid certificate from Royal Life Saving is recognised as a pre-requisite for employment by the WA Department of Police and meets the Level 2 - Workplace First Aid standard as determined by WorkSafe (Western Australia). The Senior First Aid course can be conducted in the Perth metropolitan area and many other locations in Western Australia.

The RLSSA Senior First Aid certificate is valid for three (3) years.
